Individual Use:

- 1 backpack

- 1 water bottle
- 1 pack of crayola fine line washable markers
- 2 packages of 24 Crayola Crayons regular size
- 4 dry erase markers
- 1 dry erase marker eraser
- 1 child proof pair of scissors
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 glue bottle

General Classroom Use:

- 1 pkg. of multi-color cardstock
- 1 pkg. of white cardstock
- 1 pkg. large ziploc baggies

Please also bring the following items to be kept at school in case of an emergency:

Inside a ziplock bag, labeled with your child's name on it, please include the following:

- ☐ (2) tops (one short, one long)
- ☐ (2) bottoms (one short, one long)
- ☐ (2) underwear
- ☐ (2) socks
- ☐ (2) face masks

Although TDCA is equipped with earthquake kits, we ask that you supplement the earthquake kits by providing the following. Please put all items in one sealed gallon-sized ziplock storage bag and label with your child's name.

- ☐ 2 cans of juice or fruit (with pop tops),
- ☐ 2 bottles of water,
- ☐ 2 additional food items (granola bar, can of tuna, etc),
- ☐ 2 plastic spoons or forks, and napkins.

Note: check the expiration dates and select items with long shelf lives.

These bags of emergency clothes and food will be stored in the individual classrooms and will be returned at the end of the school year.
