- ☐ 2 pairs of underwear
- ☐ 1 pair of socks

Although TDCA is equipped with earthquake kits, we ask that you supplement the earthquake kits by providing the following. Please put all items in one sealed gallon-sized ziplock storage bag and label with your child's name.

- ☐ 2 cans of juice or fruit (with pop tops),
- ☐ 2 bottles of water,
- ☐ 2 additional food items (granola bar, can of tuna, etc),
- ☐ 2 plastic spoons or forks, and napkins.

Note: check the expiration dates and select items with long shelf lives.

These bags will be stored in the individual classrooms and will be returned at the end of the school year.
